WHISTLEBLOWER PROTECTION

A “whistleblower” discloses information they reasonably believe evidences:

- A violation of any law, rule, or regulation
- Gross mismanagement
- A gross waste of funds
- An abuse of authority
- A substantial and specific danger to public health or public safety

If you witness misconduct or wrongdoing, we encourage you to speak up. Whistleblower protections that ensure confidentiality and prohibit retaliation are in place to safeguard DIA civilian employees, military service members assigned to DIA, and contractor employees. We evaluate each disclosure to determine whether there is a substantial likelihood of wrongdoing. If such a determination is made, we will investigate the matter thoroughly.
